

In compliance with federal and local law, the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division provides services to voters who require assistance in Armenian, Chinese, Farsi, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Russian Spanish, Tagalog, Thai, and Vietnamese. These services include a multilingual assistance telephone hotline, translated election materials, and multilingual assistance at targeted polling places.

To obtain language assistance over the phone, please call our toll free Multilingual Assistance Hotline at 1-800-994-8683. Individuals that call our hotline can request a translated Official Sample Ballot booklet, verify their voter registration status, and find out the location of their polling place.
